BECOMING A COUNSELOR-IN-TRAINING (CIT)

The Counselor-in-Training (CIT) program at Camp Juliette Low offers young women who have completed the 10th grade the opportunity to develop and refine skills needed to be a strong leader and qualified counselor. It is a rigorous program, comparable to a college course in outdoor leadership and education. We are pleased to send you this first year CIT packet and we hope you will apply for the program.

We want to ensure a fair application and admissions process. Here's how to apply:

1. This packet includes this letter as well as information about the first-year CIT Information form, the essay, three recommendation forms, and an return envelope. All forms are also available on the CJL website at <https://cjl.org/For-Campers/CIT-Program>.
2. Register online through CampMinder between October 1 and November 15 for the CIT session that you want to attend and pay your deposit.
3. Once you have registered, complete the CIT information form and submit your essay in CampMinder. Have your three recommendations completed and returned to you. A complete CIT application includes the online Information form and submitted essay in CampMinder as well as registering for the session of your choice. In addition, the three recommendation forms should mailed to the camp winter office with the enclosed sheet in the envelope provided. All complete and satisfactory applications received between October 1 and November 15 will be considered equally. (*Note: Incomplete applications will not be considered until they are complete; applicants will be notified after November 15 of missing information.*)
4. If there are more complete applications received by November 15 than there are spaces for the first-year CITs, there will be a lottery to determine who receives the spots. There are currently 12 spots reserved for first year CITs in each CIT session. Those not selected in the lottery will be offered a spot in another session if available or placed on a waiting list. If the 12 spots reserved for second years are not filled, then those spots will be made available to prospective first year CITs.
5. All applications received by November 15 will be processed and the CIT notified by December 15.
6. Applications received after November 15 will be considered in the order received and as space allows.
