BECOMING A SECOND YEAR CIT

The Second-Year Counselor-in-Training (CIT) program at Camp Juliette Low offers young women who have completed the 11th grade the opportunity to develop and refine skills needed to be a strong leader and qualified counselor. It is a rigorous program, comparable to a college course in outdoor leadership and education. Because you completed the program this past summer satisfactorily, we hope you will apply to be a second year CIT.

Here's how to apply:

- 1. The packet includes this letter as well as information about the second-year CIT Information form and the essay. All forms are also available on the CJL website at https://cjl.org/For-Campers/CIT-Program.
- 2. Register online through CampMinder between October 1 and November 15 for the CIT session that you want to attend and pay your deposit.
- 3. Once you have registered in CampMinder, go to Forms and you will see the CIT information form and a place to submit your essay. A complete second-year CIT application includes registering for the session of your choice, completing the online form, and uploading the essay. No recommendations are needed this year. All complete and satisfactory applications received between October 1 and November 15 will be considered equally. (Note: Incomplete applications will not be considered until they are complete; applicants will be notified after November 15 of missing information.)
- 4. If there are more complete applications received by November 15 than there are spaces for the second-year CITs, CITs will be chosen based on their evaluations and recommendations from their first-year program. There are currently 12 spots reserved for second year CITs in each CIT session. Those not selected will be offered a spot in another session if available or placed on a waiting list. If the 12 spots reserved for first years are not filled, then those spots will be made available to prospective second year CITs.
- 5. All applications received by November 15 will be processed and the CIT notified by December 15.
- 6. Applications received after Nov. 15 will be considered in the order received and as space allows.
